Class CP – Instructional Permit

Fifteen-year-olds can apply for an Instructional Permit. Please bring the following items when you visit a Department of Driver Services (DDS) Customer Service Center:

- A **Georgia DDS Certificate of School Enrollment form** must be signed and notarized from your school. It is only valid for 30 days.
- **Proper identification:** You must bring an original birth certificate, passport, certified copy of your birth certificate, certificate of birth registration, certified copy of court records (for adoption or name changes), certified naturalization records or immigration card.
- A parent or legal guardian will have to sign for you.
- Something with your full Social Security Number on it.
- You will be required to pass an Eye Test and a Written Test (*a practice Written Test is on our website*).
- The **Georgia Driver's Manual** is available online at www.dds.ga.gov.
- The license fee is \$10.00. We accept most major credit cards, debit cards and cash.

Class D – Provisional Driver's License

After having a valid Instructional Permit for one full year and one day, you may apply for your first Driver's License. Please make sure you follow these instructions:

- Schedule your **On the Road Test!** An appointment may be made up to 90 days in advance. The reservation number is (678) 413-8500, select option 3 or call (866) 754-3687 (if dialing from outside the metro-Atlanta area).
- **Coming Soon: Appointments may be made online at www.dds.ga.gov.**
- Driver's Education is required for those testing at age 16. Find out all the options at www.dds.ga.gov.
- A **Georgia DDS Certificate of School Enrollment form** must be signed and notarized from your school. It is only valid for 30 days.
- You must have the **Alcohol and Drug Awareness Program (ADAP) card** which is typically taught in health class in High School. For information about **Online ADAP (eADAP)**, you may visit www.dds.ga.gov.
- The vehicle you plan take your Driving Test in must be properly insured, registered, have a valid tag and must pass a safety inspection. Please bring a valid insurance card for the vehicle.
- You must pass an on-the-road Driving Test. The license fee is \$10.00. We accept major credit cards, debit cards and cash.
